

USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES

The Citizens of the Jamestown Public School District have provided school facilities for the specific purpose of providing educational opportunities for the students in the School District. The Jamestown School Board also encourages youth and civic activities, which contribute directly to the development of the community.

Accordingly, this board will make school buildings, equipment and facilities generally available to non-student groups for other educational, recreational, civic and cultural activities within the limits of the law so long as these activities do not interfere with the regular school program and are conducted in accordance with the Board's rules and regulations. Charges may be made for the use of facilities to cover the cost of heat, lights, custodial service, and other incidentals.

The Superintendent shall establish regulations for the community use of the school facilities, which shall include responsibility for supervision. These regulations shall be brought to the Board for approval.
