Jamestown Virtual Academy

The Jamestown Virtual Academy (JVA) is an alternative academic setting for students desiring a virtual education. The JVA is made available through the Jamestown Health and Safety Plan, which was approved by the Jamestown School Board on August 6 for the 2020/2021 school year. The JVA is meant to provide students a fully online curriculum, with teacher support, during the current crisis. A teacher will be assigned to collaborate with students and parents on student progress, to the degree necessary and practical.

Classes Offered (K-5)

The Jamestown Virtual Academy will offer students courses in English Language Arts, mathematics, social studies, and science through Prep Digital with Arizona State University. All the courses are delivered in Canvas, a learning management system. The courses are self-paced with teacher support and meant to be individualized based on student needs.

Classes Offered (6-8)

The Jamestown Virtual Academy will offer students courses in English Language Arts, mathematics, social studies, science, essential career skills, and career explorations through Prep Digital with Arizona State University. All the courses are delivered in Canvas, a learning management system. The courses are self-paced with teacher support and meant to be individualized based on student needs.

Classes Offered (9-12)

The Jamestown Virtual Academy will offer students courses dependent upon each student's interest and graduation plan through Prep Digital with Arizona State University. All the courses are delivered in Canvas, a learning management system. The courses are self-paced with teacher support and meant to be individualized based on student needs.

<u>Attendance</u>

Student attendance will be monitored daily by logging into their online course work and engaging in the content.

Parent Access

Parents will have the ability to observe student progress and support learning through Canvas.

General Provisions

- Families wishing to attend the Jamestown Virtual Academy should complete the <u>Jamestown Virtual Academy Readiness Assessment Rubric</u> to help determine the readiness of each student and family to engage in the JVA.
- 2. Students enrolling in the Jamestown Virtual Academy are committing enrolling in the JVA for at least one semester. At the end of each semester, students may be considered for enrollment back into their respective elementary schools.
- 3. Students enrolled at the Jamestown Virtual Academy will participate in a local assessment, which is required by the ND Smart-Restart guidance, in the first four weeks. JVA students will also participate in other state and local assessments of academic achievement, including assessment such as the North Dakota State Assessment

(NDSA), STAR, and FASTbridge unless other arrangements are made for assessments with the building principal and Central Office administration.
